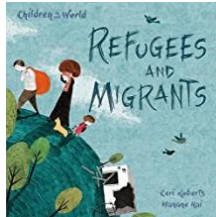

What we are learning this Autumn term...

Welcome back, I hope that you have all had a wonderful Summer holidays and are as excited as us to be back at school!



During this term in year 3, we will be focusing on our well-being and creating motivational messages that will inspire us not only in our subjects but when we are challenging ourselves.

In literacy, we will be working from the book 'Stone Age Boy' and 'UG'. From these books, we will be writing exciting action stories and factual non-chronological reports.

After half term, we will then be focusing our literacy lessons on The Iron Man – a true classic – which also links perfectly to our science topic this half term.

In maths, we will be recapping year 2 place value before introducing year 3 objectives.

During our creative afternoons, we will be learning all about the Stone Age and will be using a range of resources to help us in our quest to find out about historical events.

Class Expectations...

In year 3, Miss Chesters and Miss Breau expect you to work hard all of the time, showing pride in your work and enthusiasm to really take ownership for your own learning, becoming independent practitioners. We expect you to engage in all activities and most importantly have FUN. We want you to enjoy learning and be proud of all the exciting and interesting things you are going to learn during Year 3.

In year 3, the presentation of work is a key focus and all books should be presented to a high quality using correct layouts and above all excellent quality pieces of work to be proud of!

Handwriting will be a focus in Year 3 and we will be introducing cursive handwriting.

Attitude and behaviour is also very important and we have a wonderful house point tracker where you can put on your house points each day – Miss Chesters and Miss Breau love handing out house points. Consequences of inappropriate behaviour will result in moving up the ladder missing time from break and lunch. Also if the presentation is not of your best standard you will be asked to complete the work again.

School diaries MUST be used and should record all reading at home. This needs to be signed by a parent weekly. You are expected to read each night for 20-30mins as well as practice your times tables – we will be practising these in lessons as well.
