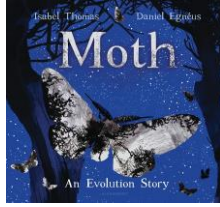
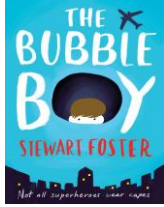


# Year 6 Newsletter Autumn 2020

What we are learning this Autumn term...

Welcome back, I hope that you have all had a wonderful Summer holiday completing some of our 'Summer Challenges'!



During this term in year 6 we will be doing lots of mindfulness and PSED sessions, which will help us to think as well as keep us happy and feeling refreshed and confident. For this we will be using the texts Brave Molly and The boy, the mole, the fox and the horse. Both beautiful books, which we will use to create a range of creative and wonderful things.

In literacy, we will be using texts recommended by Bob Cox to really develop our writing skills further and deepen our language and structure.

During our creative afternoons, we will be learning all WW2 and linking in art, DT, ICT and Music. This year our PE sessions will be taught by the sport coaches.
