Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Building Relationships—

Pupils learn how to learn and play together, turn taking, working as a team and building constructive and respectful relationships.

Managing Self -

Pupils learn how to identify and moderate their own feelings socially and emotionally.

Pupils will see themselves as valuable individuals

Self-Regultaion -

Resilience: pupils learn about different times they can ask for help. Perseverance: pupils learn how to show perseverance in the face of a challenge

Communication & Language

Speaking -

Pupils learn new vocabulary, use new vocabulary throughout the day, ask questions, use talk to help work out problems and explain how things work and why things happen.

Pupils will articulate their ideas and thoughts in well formed sentences.

Listening & Understanding -

Pupils will listen to and talk about stories to build familiarity and understanding. Pupils will listen to and talk about non fiction to develop a deep understanding Of knowledge and vocabulary. Pupils listen to rhymes, poems and songs paying attention to how they sound.

Physical Development

Fine Motor Skills - pupils will develop their fine motor skills so they can use a range of tools competently, safely and confidently.

Gross Motor Skills - children will develop confidence, competence, precision and accuracy when engaging in activities that involve a ball. Pupils will develop overall body strength, balance, coordination and agility.

Mathematics

Number - pupils will be able to subitise (recognise quantities without counting) up to 5. Pupils will learn number sequences, reasoning and counting irregular arrangements.

Numerical Patterns - Pupils will understand composition and decomposition of numbers up to 5.

Children will learn how to measure using non standard and standard units of measure. Children will learn about 3D shapes.

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Expressive Arts & Design

Being Imaginative & Expressive - Pupils will listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses. Pupils will develop storylines in their pretend play.

Creating With Materials - Pupils will explore ,use and refine a variety of different effects to express their ideas and feelings. Pupils will learn about primary and secondary colours.

Literacy

Writing - Pupils will lean how to form lower-case letters correctly. Pupils will spell words by identifying the sounds and writing the sound with letters. Pupils will begin to write short sentences, thinking about a capital letter and a full stop. Pupils will learn how to write their full name.

Word Recognition - Pupils will blend sounds into words so that they can read short words. Pupils will read a few common exception words matched to the Little Wandle phonic program. Pupils will re-read books to build up their confidence in word reading and fluency.

Comprehension - Pupils will re-read books to build up their confidence in understanding of what they are reading.

Understanding the World

Past & Present - Pupils will learn about transport, past and present. Pupils will learn about long ago and now.

Our world- Pupils will learn to understand the world around us., using a map they will learn about different countries. Pupils will learn about how weather effects our world and how to care for our environment.

People, Culture & Communities – Pupils will learn how Christians look after the world. Pupils will learn about the Chinese/ Lunar New Year, Easter, important people and God.

The Natural World - Pupils will learn about winter, the sun, moon and stars. Pupils will learn about shadows, day and night. Pupils will learn about Spring, plants and the weather.
